Offertory - Contactless Payment Devices: Newer, faster Digital Collection Plates are now in operation at Sacred Heart Church and Wardour Chapel. The banking facility, which was provided by SumUp is now provided by Stripe, at a slightly reduced transaction percentage fee. This means that Gift Aid donors have to set up the Gift Aid again for each card used. The personal Gift Aid information previously held by SumUp is not being handed over to Stripe. **I apologise for the inconvenience, but the increased speed and lower bank charges make it worthwhile.** The 'Chip and PIN' card slot is now at the bottom of the card reader (with the SumUp devices it was at the top). As previously, there will be a payment option on the Parish web page within Salisbury Catholics website, but it is currently misbehaving.
