This may be useful to higher rate taxpayers. On the subject of Gift Aid, if you have a signed Declaration in place, and now find that you do not pay income tax, it is extremely important that you inform the treasurer, since HMRC could ask you to repay the tax wrongly paid to the Parish. A Declaration can easily be cancelled as circumstances dictate, but not retrospectively.
