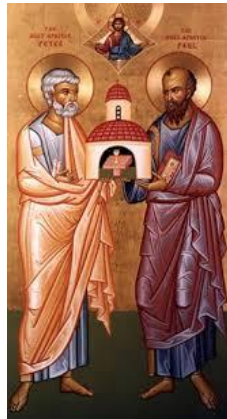

SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF GLASTONBURY Sunday 7th September

The theme for this year's Pilgrimage is "Mary, Woman of Hope," which aligns with the Jubilee Year's theme of "Pilgrims of Hope". As well as the usual Rosary Procession around Glastonbury town centre at 1.45 p.m., there will be an additional procession in the morning to celebrate the Jubilee, starting from the Shrine Church and proceeding to the top of Glastonbury Tor. The relics of St Columba will be on display in the Shrine on Pilgrimage Day. 3.00pm MASS, Abbey grounds celebrated by Bishop Bosco MacDonald.
