

#### Youth group trip to Queen of Martyrs & St Ignatius Church

On Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> August, a minibus full of youth driven by Father Joseph left Salisbury for a day's adventure. Simultaneously cars came from Tisbury with more youth! We visited the secret Mass chamber in the loft with its very old wall paintings, the sacristy including artefacts from penal times including a priest's travelling altar, with its true purpose hidden. The church is a true gem and we heard more of its history as Father Joseph celebrated Mass, remembering the seven Chideock martyrs who died between 1587 to 1642. It was a fitting day to be there as it was the memorial of three other Martyrs- Margeret Clitherow, Anne Line and Margaret Ward. We completed our visit to this beautiful Chapel by venerating the relics of St Thomas More, St Edmund Campion, St Cuthbert Maine, the true Cross and Ven Thomas Pilchard. We walked to the beach at Seatown after our picnic lunch in the Museum and spent some time on the blustery beautiful beach before returning home.
