RORATE MASS at Wardour Chapel, Saturday 13th December, 7 a.m. Fr Joseph will celebrate a dawn, candlelight 'Rorate Mass' (new rite, sung Latin). A 'Rorate Mass' is

traditionally celebrated in Advent in honour of Our Lady. It is lit only by candles, as a representation of Mary's role in bringing the Light of the World

into the darkness of our world.

It takes its name from the introit for Votive Masses of Our Lady in Advent:

'Rorate cæli desuper, et nubes pluant justum' (Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness). All welcome.
