Four years ago, a mother and her young daughter arrived from Odesa and were welcomed into our community. They are now settled locally in Donhead St Andrew, with the mother working hard and the daughter thriving at our local school. Following a direct bombing, the mother's elderly parent and brother now urgently need to leave Ukraine. The brother has permission to travel as he is his mother's carer. The original sponsor family are sadly unable to sponsor them but are hoping to find someone locally ideally with an annexe or separate living space who might be able to help. The family would be well supported by the daughter, who drives and works nearby. The commitment would be a minimum of six months, with no clear end point while the war continues. If you know of anyone who might be willing to consider this, we would be very grateful. Thank you so much for helping us spread the word.
