If faith is left unfed, it falters easily. If it is learned, shared, and prayed, it becomes steady and strong enough for the long road.

Refurbishment of Parish Room and Flat

A huge thank you to those of who have already made generous donations towards this project. The work on West End House is now due to proceed as quickly as the builder can make it happen. The intention is firmly established to create a porch and entrance facing towards Sacred Heart Church, but this will need more planning consent, which will take time. It will also require more donations and Diocesan approval. The work on the Flat will however proceed as quickly as possible, so as to start receiving rental income.

Gift Aid. For those able to Gift Aid their donations, now is an excellent time to donate as we near the end of the tax year. For those paying higher rate tax, the Parish can claim the basic rate, but you can claim the higher rate tax back via your tax return. To that end, the treasurer can provide you with a letter stating the full amount of your Gift Aided donations to (or via) the Parish within the 2025/26 tax year.
