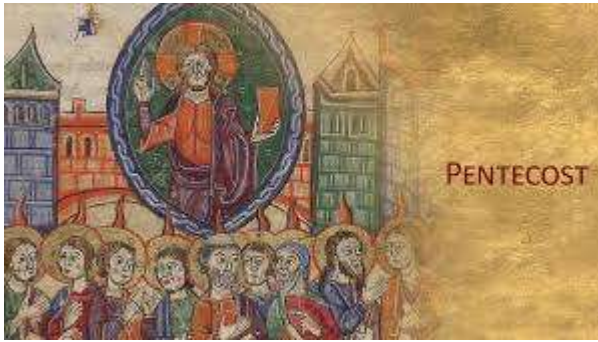

### **Relics of St Gerard Majella**

*The relics of St Gerard Majella are being taken around the country, and they will be visiting St Osmund's church in Salisbury on Friday 5th June. St Gerard was born in Italy in 1726 to a poor family, and died aged only 29, but he was a Redemptorist brother known for his quiet holiness, humility, and mystical prayer. He is a powerful patron saint of mothers and unborn children, and especially couples struggling to conceive, or having difficulties in pregnancy. He is also a patron saint of those looking for work, and of making a good confession. Catholics have always honoured the relics of saints, as a very tangible way to give God glory for their lives, and to ask for a share of the blessings given to them. St Gerard's relics will be honoured at a special Mass at 6pm, followed by blessings with the relics and opportunity for Confessions.*
