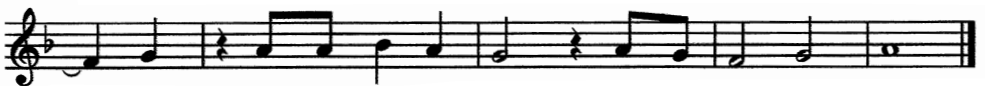

wash me with water flowing from thy side.


Strength and protection may thy Passion be;
