#### Six Women of the Bible

Fr Denis is Director of Redemptorist Publications. Fr Denis has studied the New Testament at Union Theological Seminary, New York, and after winning a scholarship to Harvard University returned to England to work at Hawkstone Hall, the international pastoral centre in Shropshire. Since then, his principal areas of interest and writing have been the human story and the Gospels. Before taking up his current position, Denis directed courses of study and personal renewal for priests, religious, and lay people. He has lectured in parish halls, colleges and universities to a variety of groups - including bishops' conferences - in North America, Africa, Asia, including the Arabian Peninsula, Australia, New Zealand, and throughout Europe.

His lectures are not only informative and enlightening, but his delivery is entertaining and compelling. He has written 14 books and produced 56 CDs, each an absorbing reflection on God's saving work.


# PRAYER
