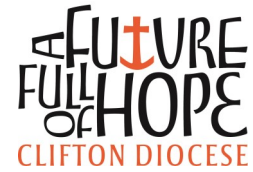
### From Father Anthony

Early morning mist obscured rooftops and curled round brightly coloured hollyhocks. Cathedral bells muffled the hour; tea steamed. It was quiet. Then, Gangsters and Spivs descended; the lawn became a battle ground. Brown Sparrows circled above, providing top cover: the Gunslinger adjudicated from the stump. The noise was horrendous! However, a bold Blackbird hopped right through the centre of the battle. Whilst others fought over peanuts he found them and tucked in, taking occasional sips from the bird bath. There had to be a lesson here, I thought.

Last week we saw the conflict that arises when a person begins to wake from worldly to spiritual understanding (*prophet in his home town*). The old, worldly person rejects the new-found spiritual person within; no transformation (*miracles*) can take place because faith in our own transformation is weak, confused and world-bound. It can be a dark, uncomfortable time.

This week Jesus sends the twelve out in pairs. It can be wise and reassuring to make long difficult journeys in company with another; behind this worldly wisdom there lies a spiritual reality. We have to make a spiritual journey right through the centre of the tension and conflict we find between the old and new person within. Instead of another person we have to identify and gather together our spiritual faculties (*the twelve*) and pair them off (*send them off in twos*); Peter and Andrew (*faith and strength*), James and John (*wisdom and love*), and so on. The discovery of and pairing off of these faculties is a large part of the spiritual journey itself. To do it we must *lean on* and *trust* only in the Spirit (*Staff*); and allow the Spirit to lead us (*Sandals*). We must relinquish the hold the world has on us (*carry no purse, money or bread*) and be of one mind (*no second tunic*). When our worldly thoughts intrude we must brush them off (*shake the dust*). Where spirit begins to take hold and make sense, we should settle and rest allowing it to teach and feed us (*stay in the same house eating what is provided*).

The interior journey begins by responding to an interior call. This call will be heard when we truly long for a new way. The word used for *call* is *proskaleó* (προσκαλέω): *I call to myself*. It is a call from the Lord residing in our centre (*I Am*).
