## ODINARY TIME WEEK 11(A)

## From Father Anthony

I sat on high ground against a stone wall. It was warm. A light breeze sighed through branches and ruffled leaves. A crow eyed me suspiciously. The gentle curves of Cranborne Chase rolled away to the horizon clothed in garments of green, brown and yellow. A tractor groaned: cattle moaned. Sheep gathered around a battered Pickup. The Great Spire, small in the distance, glinted Portland white, indicating Salisbury hidden amid a ruff of treetops. I thought about all the souls living and working there; *human sheep* going about their business beneath the gentle sun... each and every one known and loved by God.

'When Jesus saw the crowds he felt sorry for them because they were harassed and dejected, like sheep without a shepherd'. The word translated as sorry, splagchnizomai ( $\sigma\pi\lambda\alpha\gamma\chi\nu(\zeta o\mu\alpha)$ ), 'to feel compassion', comes from splanxna ( $\sigma\pi\lambda\dot{\alpha}\gamma\chi\nu\alpha$ ), 'to be moved in the *inward parts*, especially the heart, lungs, liver, and kidneys: hence the association with our feelings and affections or *gut level* compassion. The image is powerful. Jesus looks upon us; His *inward parts* are moved; He has compassion for us in His guts, because we are, to Him, lost and alone like sheep without a shepherd.

The world needs compassion and love. It might laugh at and reject us as Christians... but consciously or subconsciously it looks to us for love and compassion. Love is abundant; it resides in each and every one of us *as us;* yet few offer it. This is our spiritual labour; to awaken the love which we are and offer it to others. Many of us operate and offer the mechanisms of the world; and we are applauded for it. But love?

Love is not a commodity; it is what we actually are. To 'find it' means to allow what we truly are to surface, expand and flourish. To 'awaken it' we must hear Him call our name, as He called the Apostles: hear Him tell us not to be preoccupied with the worldly (sinful) side of our nature (pagan territories) but go to those areas where faith can grow (the lost sheep of the house of Israel). Here we will connect with His compassion and understanding. Here we will feel Him Love us; this Love will kindle the love which we are. And because Love only knows the other, spends no time on itself ... we will naturally offer Love to others.


