From Father Anthony

I ruffled Mrs Cat's head and scratched her chin... and received a glare for such impertinence! Gloves on, heater blowing I then navigated the jalopy across to Tisbury. It was a beautiful frosty day: clear blue sky, pastel colours and early morning haze. The Great Spire waved goodbye in the rear-view mirror, the sun smiled and cars sped by. Deeper into the rolling countryside, through twists and turns it felt good to be alive: just perfect!

'Be perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect'. The word used for 'perfect' is teleios (τέλειος): it conveys completeness or reaching the end of a process. We might say wholeness. The spiritual life is a movement towards wholeness: to live in such a way that we always assimilate whatever happens to us into wholeness or completeness: our life contains no gaps. Increasingly, our life mirrors the desires or wishes God has for us. Living in this manner we modify or transform ourselves and the world.

One way of arriving at wholeness is to become aware of what we are resistant to. Most of us aspire towards something: we wish our lives were different in some way: we day dream. In reality life is found in the moment and all that takes place in that moment... including the day dream! We push away moments of our life because they don't fit in with our wishes or dreams. Yet it is these moments where we find ourselves and God. 'Receive your demon', the wise ones used to say, 'keep it close, because if you push it out the door it will come in through the window; if you push it out the window it will come down the chimney; if you block up the chimney it will come up through the cellar. You will be forever tied to it! Receive it: change it by the love present in your reception of it.'

We are not asked to be led by the world or by day to day events: we are not asked or agree with or condone them. We are asked to receive them so that by our reception of them they are changed (*transformed*)... by our love. When two forces unite they produce a force that neither possessed singly. Thus, Jesus asks us to turn the other cheek, to go the extra mile, not to turn away... to transform the world by our loving embrace!


