OUR CHURCH TV - VIEWING FIGURES

As you know, our Church TV which enables housebound and elderly parishioners to join us online for Mass and prayer continues to grow in popularity and is now being accessed by people in all sorts of different circumstances from many different locations. We continue to receive a lot of positive feedback from parishioners who watch and pray with us which is wonderful but we would also like to share with you some of the viewing figures which the system is able to monitor.

As of 7 February (8 months since we went 'live'):

5000 viewing sessions of a duration of one hour or more (e.g. an entire Sunday Mass)

17,414 viewing sessions of a duration between 5 minutes and 1 hour (e.g. Weekday Mass or time of Adoration)

Total Number of Viewing Hours - **25,600 hours**.

Last Sunday alone, 541 joined the livestream at some point with 49 of those staying with the service for one hour or more.

Thank you once again to everyone who had the vision and generosity to support this outreach project when we appealed for funds last year. Your contribution has meant so much to so many people and is enabling the spread of the Gospel and the upbuilding of our community. Thank you very much - Fr Michael.

As we come before the Lord who calls us, forms us and gifts us to be his disciples, we are called on his terms and to be disciples as he needs us to be, so we appreciate how much in need of him we are. He calls us in spite of our weakness and our inadequacies and his choice of us might seem foolish at times... but he calls us to know him, to come close to him and then draw others to us, 'catching' them, for him. Let's pray to trust him... he knows what he is about.
