RURAL CATHOLICS

Fifteenth National Conference to be held at Sarum College, Salisbury from 25 to 27 February 2019. Many of the parishes in Clifton diocese include large rural areas. The annual National Conference for Rural Catholics is an opportunity for clergy and parishioners to have a look at what goes on outside the town. It is attended by clergy and laity from around England and Wales. The 2019 Conference returns to our diocese in the comfort of Sarum College, in Salisbury Cathedral Close, February 25-27. It is handy by train, car or 'bus. Attendance is residential or part-day. Programme includes the work of the Parliamentary EFRA Committee, the 'paper' farmer, the changing world of modern farm machinery, training for rural ministry, the rural Post Office; visit a fish farm or Salisbury water meadows etc..

SCORE update

At the December SCORE meeting the following grants were made: Alabaré received £3,000 towards its rough sleeper initiative. This will be match funded by a very generous donor, thus doubling the grant. Rise:61 received £2,000 towards its missionary work with young people in Bemerton Heath. Presentation Sisters in Pakistan received £2,500 to support their work providing education to some of the poorest children in Sindh. Applications for grants can be made using the form on the website and should reach the committee before the next SCORE meeting on 4 March, at 7.30pm in St Osmund's Presbytery.

ST OSMUND'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL — ADMISSIONS 2019

If you hope for your child to join the Reception class at St Osmund's Catholic Primary School next September you need to apply now. The Council's Common Admissions Form needs to be returned to Wiltshire Council at County Hall in Trowbridge; and the school's Supplementary Form needs to be returned to St Osmund's Primary School. The closing date for receiving applications is Tuesday 15 January 2019 for both Wiltshire Council and St Osmund's School. Applications to St Osmund's should be supported by a copy of your child's baptismal certificate.

These forms can be submitted electronically to Wiltshire County Council, Trowbridge and St Osmund's School. St Osmund's school must also receive a baptismal certificate
