Having driven all the way from Ukraine, which took rather longer and was much more expensive than they had presumed, they arrived here with very little money. Oksana has been deeply touched by the welcome she and her children have received and it is wonderful to see how – two months on – they are really beginning to find their feet. Of course the future is very uncertain, but at least together we have been able to give them a safe and secure haven.*
