Our Parish Collection for The Disasters Emergency Committee for Ukraine

Donations for the Ukraine appeal up to 9th March, by cheque, cash, contactless and on-line have so far totalled **£811.00**. A final tally will be made on 15th March, so any donations made up to that date will be included.

Mass intention on 15th March: RIP Kate Howden. She was a Merchant Navy Captain's daughter, and young widow of a MN Captain. In the 1890s she was recruited by its two Jesuit founders as a supporter in London's East End of the newly founded Apostleship of the Sea. Moving to Glasgow she kept pressing the Parish Priest, Fr Egger SJ at St Aloysius' Garnet Hill, to do something for seafarers. Almost single-handed she stirred and recruited enough for a branch of the AoS, with ship-visiting and literature distribution, to come about. World War 1 shut the docks. She died in 1919. In Glasgow Bro Dan Shields SJ introduced Peter Anson - who usually gets the credit for founding the AoS - to what remained of the AoS and Kate Howden is largely forgotten. A remarkable woman, effectively the mother of the AoS. Her 2019 anniversary was edged out by Covid lockdown.*RM*
