"Without prayer there will be no Synod"

The Synod in Rome begins on 1st October. All Catholics and others around the world are looking with interest and praying for inspiration from the Holy Spirit, asking God for His guidance as the Synod in Rome begins. To help become part of this, we have been asked to make this an event of prayer and listening so that with the members of the Synodal Assembly every baptized person and every particular Parish Church prays together. Cardinal Grech speaks of the four facets of prayer in the Synod.

1. Listening. Prayer begins with "listening to the Word of God and the Spirit."

2. Adoration. The importance of "adoring silence in awe for what God is saying to his Church and for what the Spirit arouses in the Church today."

3. Intercession. Intercessory prayer, not about bending God's will to ours, but asking the Lord to enlighten our hearts with the power of His life-giving Spirit so that we might discern and do His will.

4. Thanksgiving. Encouraging gratitude. The prayer of thanksgiving is a true 'therapy' that moves us from our withdrawal into ourselves to the openness that is able to discover all that God continues to work in His Church."

We hope to incorporate these in our Parish and join together when we can do so.
