### **FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT (YEAR B)**

During Advent there will be **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Adoration** at Sacred Heart from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. When Father Jonathan is available he will say Mass at 9 a.m. after Morning Prayer and conclude Adoration with Benediction. Please sign up for the first two weeks of Advent in the porch.

**Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> December, 7am – Fr Joseph will celebrate a dawn, candlelight 'Rorate Mass' at Wardour (new rite sung Latin). A 'Rorate Mass' is traditionally celebrated in Advent in honour of Our Lady. It is lit only by candles, as a representation of Mary's role in bringing the Light of the World into the darkness of our world. It takes its name from the introit for Votive Masses of Our Lady in Advent: 'Rorate caeli desuper, et nubes pluant justum' (Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness). All welcome!**
