Knitting for AoS: Father hopes to bless the hats at the 9 a.m. Mass on Sunday 20th December which is the delayed Sea Sunday. Please bring any woolly hats you have knitted to the box in the Foyer of Sacred Heart before that weekend. **Have a go at knitting a hat.** If you need needles or DK/Aran wool we can provide and the pattern is straightforward (!) Cast on 108 stitches using 4.5 or 5mm needles. K2 P2 for 23cms (9”) and cast off by reducing or K2Together. Seafarers are in desperate need and not just for hats. <https://www.stellamaris.org.uk/>
