New Lectionary for England and Wales

It is expected that the Bishops will complete the approval process in Autumn 2021. The text will then need to be reviewed by the Holy See and others. The earliest date for publication would therefore be in 2022. It will be important that People's Missals and other ancillary material are available at the time of publication.

Lenten prayer chain for victims of Covid

Bishops from all over Europe, through their Bishops' Conferences, will join together during Lent to celebrate a series of Masses and pray for the victims of Covid-19. The continent has suffered over 770,000 deaths from the virus. The initiative, promoted by the Council of European Bishops' Conferences (CEE), aims to offer a sign of communion and hope for the entire continent. Each nation will come together to celebrate Holy Mass on a designated day to be part of this continental prayer network – a Eucharistic chain. Cardinal Vincent Nichols will celebrate a special **live-streamed Mass on Tuesday, 2 March 2021, at 1730 in Westminster Cathedral**. Bishops across England and Wales will also celebrate Masses in their own dioceses.
