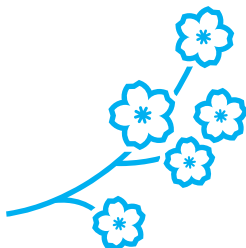

**Starting School?** If your child is four years old before September 2023, apply now for a place at Wardour Catholic Primary School. You must complete an application form available from the school admissions team of your Local Authority – that is the County Council of the county in which you reside. **Please ensure you apply by the closing date of 15 January 2023.** Wardour School is a super choice for parishioners: the school was awarded a Good Ofsted report just before the Covid lockdown and has an excellent Head Teacher in Emma Dixon, who is ably supported by a loyal and committed staff. ***Lectio Divina*** is a slow, rhythmic reading and praying of a Scripture passage. You pick a passage and read it.
