## **POPE FRANCIS - Audience 6 June**

Dear brothers and sisters: In our continuing catechesis on Confirmation, we now consider some of its effects. The sign of peace exchanged by the Bishop and the newly confirmed is a reminder that each must work for the upbuilding of the community in faith, love and Christian service. May we who have received this sacrament open our hearts each day to the liberating breath of the Holy Spirit and fan into flame the gifts we have received for the good of one another, the whole Church and the world in which we live.
