Traditionally, these are the topics for the homilies preached on the four Sundays of Advent, and this year our clergy have planned a series of talks on these topics to help us to engage more deeply in the beautiful season of Advent and prepare our hearts and minds for Christmas and beyond.

THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM

As of September 2024, St George's, Warminster has no resident priest and will be served by the clergy of our Pastoral Area. This has had a knock-on effect to our arrangements for Holy Week 2025. The highlight of our liturgical year is our celebration of The Paschal Triduum and we are pleased that current clergy provision (four priests) in our Pastoral Area means that each *parish* can still host this great celebration: Sacred Heart, Tisbury with Wardour; Christ the King, Amesbury; St George's, Warminster; and the Parish of St Osmund, Salisbury.

As Salisbury has two beautiful and well-attended churches, the celebration of the Triduum will take place across both venues. Just as the Triduum is one liturgy in three parts, so we will celebrate as one parish in our two locations. This will be a wonderful opportunity to come together as a single unified community regardless of which building we usually attend, and we will be looking to provide 'overflow' provision at both venues where possible.
