## Hope Exchange, Cape Town.

Hope Exchange provided thousands of nutritious meals to homeless people in Cape Town from mid-December to mid-January as part of its FEED5000 project. The city has an estimated 14,000 homeless people.

On Christmas Day 782 meals were served.

**CRESS** (Christian Relief and Education for South Sudanese)

CRESS is based in Broad Chalke and was founded in 2011. It works with refugees from South Sudan who have moved to Northern Uganda.

The grant from SCORE will cover the cost of half the medicines supplied by its health clinics in 2025. Common problems are malaria and typhoid, and 1 in 23 children do not reach their first birthday.

"Your generosity makes a vital difference to the health of those who otherwise wouldn't be able to afford good quality healthcare. As a small charity, your support over the years has been vital to the continuing of the clinic".
