# EASTER WEEK 5

# From Father Anthony

I stood, chin wagging, in the market. The sun beamed, a light breeze ruffled the trees, gulls circled overhead noisily competing with stall owners for attention. As always, it was a pleasant jumble of sights, sounds and movements. Resembling a pack horse I made for home. Down Catherine Street, along St Johns. Some way down Exeter Street, a brave lady stopped the traffic and assisted another lady with a Zimmer frame, across the road. There were smiles and waves from drivers: no horns, no antagonism; a simple, lovely moment of love and care.

"This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." There are four words in Biblical Greek for our one-word Love. Jesus is not referring to love characterised as best mates, Philia ( $\varphi\iota\lambda i\alpha$ ): nor erotic, romantic love, Eros ( $\xi \rho\omega \varsigma$ ): nor the fierce, protective, yet affectionate love between family members, Storge ( $\sigma\tau o\rho\gamma\dot{\eta}$ ). He is referring to another quality; love characterised as unconditional and self-giving, Agape ( $\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$ ). It is a quality of preferring what the other prefers. It is not the easiest word to translate. In a sense it means attempting to inhabit the life of another person; seeing the world from their perspective; not using one's own life as the measure against which to understand and compare theirs but embracing them as they are without condition. It means leaving one's own life; dying to it, for the sake of understanding the other person. We attempt to become one with the other person. We go beyond ourselves for others, ever attentive to their needs. However idealistic this may sound the world would be a very different place if we all Loved like this.

Jesus calls you and me to follow Him; to listen out for and hear His call. He also asks us to Love as He did. We may not like others but that is not the same as loving them; and we are called to Love (Agape) them, understand them, be as them. Loving in this manner draws us out of ourselves. It allows us to experience Christ in them and see ourselves from their perspective; and what needs transforming in ourselves. Similarly, knowing (feeling) them as they are in themselves, we know what needs transforming in them and can offer it. Attempting to Love like this is the hallmark of His disciples. It should be our hallmark too!
