# Ordinary Time Week 31(C)

#### **From Father Anthony**

I woke early, made some tea and went outside. It was dark, the air clear and silent. Above, lit by a smile from the moon, stars twinkled in velvety blackness. Wisps of cloud moved like ghosts across the vast expanse. It felt fresh and pure. Later, whilst hosing down the mess caused by Harry the Pigeon and friends – who continue their 'illegal occupancy' of the church tower - and with dark clouds hurling down buckets of rain, I found it hard to believe that beyond it all was the pure scene of earlier. Same world; two aspects of it. The Gunslinger perched smugly with a look that suggested, 'at last he's found his true vocation'... Mrs Cat had long gone!

The Greek name Zacchaeus, from the Hebrew Zakkay , 'means 'pure', 'innocent', 'purified'. Spiritually Zacchaeus can stand for aspects of you and me. As created by God we are pure and spotless, His pride and joy. What we have made of ourselves may have tarnished that purity. In the case of Zacchaeus his beautiful, natural stature had become small and diminished through his sense of lack and consequential greed and avarice. Thinking only of himself he had trampled over others. Even the vantage point he used to gain sight of Jesus is a tree that bears bitter fruit! Yet the impulse to see Jesus (*be with God*) was still with him. Essentially, beyond the mess he had made of his life, he was still the pure, marvellous creature created by God. His basic form was undiminished; only the content needed rearranging and transforming.

Lovingly Jesus called him down from the height of his error and selfishness... so that they could reside together (*hurry down I must stay with you today*). These words are addressed to you and me too! The effect was massively transformative for Zacchaeus. His sense of lack transformed into a sense of plenty as he promised to share with those he has trampled on and began to fulfil the spiritual law of *love your neighbour as yourself*.

Together, let's take heart. Whatever we have made of our lives God is not there with a wagging finger but with love and understanding. If we really want Him, He will live with us and occupy, with us, the life we are leading. This relationship will bring internal security, comfort, balance and poise and our original innocence will shine through.
